

Patient preparation for breast magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) scan

- breast MRI scan is to be performed between the 5th and 12th day of a menstrual cycle (counting from the 1st day of a menstrual cycle) in women of reproductive age
- if you use a hormone replacement therapy, it should be interrupted 3 weeks before the breast MRI scan
- recent creatinine and urea blood test results are required since the imaging can be performed with an application of contrast agent
 If you decided to do these lab tests at our laboratory, please come one hour before the scheduled MRI.

Please bring the following documents upon arrival:

- urea and creatinine laboratory test results
- medical history and previous mammography result, in case you have undergone one.
