

Patient preparation for prostate biopsy

One day before the biopsy:

please take 1 to 2 Dulcolax tablets in the morning. Gently insert Dulcolax laxative suppository into the rectum in the evening.
Start taking Ciprofloxacin 2 x 500 mg tbl. therapy and continue with this therapy for another 4 days. The therapy is to be taken for a total of 5 days.

On the day of the biopsy:

 it is important to defecate and empty your colon in the morning. You do not have to be on an empty stomach.

Warfarin, acetylsalicylic acid, diclofenacum therapy or other drug that affects the blood clotting time i.e. anticoagulation drug therapy, must be interrupted at least 5 days before the planned biopsy.

You must bring the laboratory results: L, glucose, PT, APTT, platelet aggregation test, urine, urine culture, which must not be older than 14 days. If you were receiving anticoagulation drug therapy, then the coagulation profile result has to be recent.
